# Despite its popularity, *Pyrus calleryana* is subject to storm damage, vandalism, fireblight and delayed graft incompatibility. New cultivars listed are superior to 'Bradford' in susceptibility to storm damage but not necessarily in fireblight resistance. Long term performance of new cultivars remains unproven.
